

FINANCIAL <u>AID</u>

We ask you to consult your band council or even the school institution from your community to verify your eligibility for financial aid. They can check with you to see to what you are entitled.

If you do not have access to financial support from your community, the CEGEP puts a service at your disposal at the Val-d'Or Campus that informs you about the Quebec government financial aid program in addition to accompaniment in your process to get loans and bursaries. ADMISSION FEES

You must send a cheque or money order in the amount of \$30 made out to the Cégep de l'Abitibi-Témiscamingue for us to activate your file.

2 DULY COMPLETED APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION FORM

Please take care to properly read the form and fill it out (in block letters) as correctly as possible. Remember to sign and put the date on it.

3 A COPY OF YOUR DIPLOMAS (SSD/DES OR SSVD/DVS/DEP)

A copy of your Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or Secondary School Vocational Diploma/Diploma of Vocational Studies (SSVD/DVS) that you obtained according to your education

4 FORM FOR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION BASED ON TRAINING DEEMED SUFFICIENT

This concerns only those that do not have a diploma (SSD or SSVD/VDS).

5 COPY OF YOUR MOST RECENT TRANSCRIPT FROM THE MINISTÈRE DE L'ÉDUCATION

6 YOUR MOST RECENT RÉSUMÉ

We need this to authenticate your eligibility regarding criteria from College Education Regulations (CER).

7_COPY OF YOUR BIRTH CERTIFICATE FROM THE DIRECTEUR DE L'ÉTAT CIVIL

This document is mandatory. It must come from the Directeur de l'état civil (Registrar of Civil Status) from your province of birth and include the name of your father and mother. Documents that are often titled baptistère (baptistery) which originate from your parish are not recognized. Please send only readable copies.

8 VALID COPY OF YOUR INDIAN STATUS CARD

9 VALID COPY OF YOUR RAMQ HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

10 COMPLETED AUTHORIZATION FORM FOR RELEASE OF MEDICAL INFORMATION
